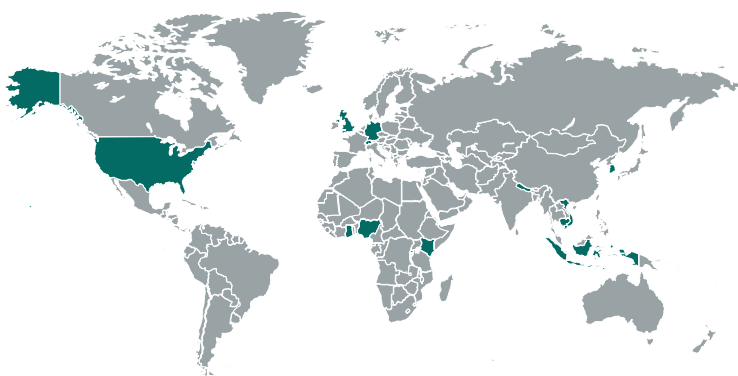
Target Audience
